

Stop 1 Laboratory: The miracle of metamorphosis begins here! Behind the glass are butterfly eggs and larva in different stages of growth. Affectionately called "munching machines", butterfly larva do nothing but eat at this stage in the life cycle. Butterfly World has raised over 1,000,000 butterflies!

Stop 2 Paradise Adventure Aviary: Thrill to the brilliant beauty of live butterflies from five continents. Observe them in their natural habitat as they fly around you, feed and bask in the sun.

Stop 3 Hanging Garden & Butterfly Emerging Area: Flower filled hanging baskets line one side. Butterfly

pupa emerging cases line the other. Witness the miracle of metamorphosis as new butterflies emerge each day! Don't miss the surprising sensitive plants that close at your touch!

Stop 4 Tropical Rain Forest: Thousands of exotic butterflies and families of free flying birds soar in this simulation of the real rain forest, the jewel of Butterfly World. Explore the pathways leading to the cave and waterfall. Be prepared for periodic showers in this area.

Stop 5 Grace Gardens: Stroll along the banks of the lake and enjoy the colors of our blooming botanical gardens, showcasing some of the most beautiful flowering tropical specimens in the world, and named in honor of the wife of our founder. Wild butterflies abound here, attracted by the many nectar plants and food sources for caterpillars.

Stop 6 Vine Maze to Tropical Bird Aviary: Explore the vine-covered maze on your way to a delightful Tropical Bird Aviary. This "secret garden" houses one of the largest collections of Passion- flowers in the world! Then, marvel at the antics of swift flying, singing birds of the tropics. Continue your enjoyment with a snack at the Garden Gazebo Courtyard Café.

Stop 7 English Rose Garden: Enjoy the timeless beauty & delightful fragrance of roses. Up to 20 different varieties bloom year-round.

Stop 8 Lorikeet Encounter: Meet the friendly clowns of the bird world in our hands-on Lorikeet Encounter! Originally from Australia, these lovable, rainbow-feathered birds are a delight. Purchase a cup of nectar, and they'll eat right out of your hand!

Stop 9 Tinalandia Bridge, Macaw Landing & Jewels of the Sky Aviary: Step into adventure on our swinging suspension bridge, a rocking, rolling replica of one found in the real rain forest! Next, say "Hello" to our Macaws, Butterfly World's loudest residents, all donated or rescued domestically. Then, discover the amazing world of tropical birds as they buzz around you, flitting and feeding in a flower-filled habitat. Be sure to look for the families of rainbow-colored Gouldian finches that call this home.

Stop 10 Butterfly Museum and Bug Zoo: Visit this

spectacular collection of insects, butterflies and moths from around the world. Don't miss the brilliant blue Morpho butterflies! Next, you will see Butterfly World's live Bug Zoo, where you can see Scorpions, Madagascar Hissing Cockroaches, Millipedes, Tarantulas and so much more. You name it- we have it-up close, in "easy view" natural habitats.

Stop 11 Butterfly Garden Center: Start your own butterfly garden at home with these plants. Butterfly World stocks all the "hard to find" species you will need to turn your home into a paradise for butterflies. Butterfly Gardening Classes are offered each month.
